**C Treat and Scan** rectify to **85** or above

**DBL C** *White* background of screen to treat entire item - rectify to **85** or above

**C** Ear & etc (there are many selections here that are excellent for Detoxing)

**C** small white circle to open screen

**DBL C** White background of screen to treat entire item - repaired to 85 or above

**DBL C** individual specific name - repaired to 85 or above
