## CHAPTER 3

### INDIVIDUAL REACTIONS

It is wise not to over use this function as the client's unconscious may perceive it as a persistent grilling.

#### Method

From the Test Screen you may choose to test an item individually.

**C one of the Red items** (this highlights the item)  
**C Individual Reaction** (on the right of the screen or "N" on your key board)

**A yellow box will appear.**

✓ *Hint:* Item can be zapped for 30 seconds or 3 min. from this screen or 3 sec. by "T" on your key board.

★ *Option:*

**C Interpret Results** (this can provide helpful messages)  
For further clarity:  
**C Retest Item Toxic or Needed**  
**Brings up questions which can focus the retest - wait until it finishes.**  
**C Interpret Results**  
**Zap item until rectified is 100 or more.**

## Interpreting the Results

**Total Reaction:** shows the total reactivity to a substance.

**Allergic Reaction:** shows an allergic or toxic reaction. Above **85** indicates an allergic reaction.

**Difference:** reveals an allergic tendency if low or a nutritional need if high.

**Resonance:** shows how much the client needs this item. Above **80** reveals need.

**Coherence:** a high number will help confirm the nutritional need.

**Rectified:** if this is over **85** then the energetic correction is complete for now.

**Fourier Chaos Harmonic:** a number relating to the adaption response to the testing.

**High Reactivity and a low resonance indicates that there is an ongoing need for the item.**

**Reactance is high and only one of Resonance / Coherence is high, indicates short term use of the item.**

## **Subfiles** (see **Figure 9** – pg 21)

These are categories of items to the center right of the Test screen.

**C** on any subfile to bring up all items relating to the category. Check the ones that are of special interest to you, making note of highest numbers and any patterns or items that repeat.

## **Hold Trays** (see **Figure 9** – pg 21)

### **On the Test Screen**

Items showing on the Matrix provide clues to useful therapies and products. Items which repeat, are extremely high or of particular interest to you are good choices for utilizing a **hold tray** to gain further information.

**C Item of choice** (this highlights the item , **Figure 9** – pg 21)  
**Drag and Drop** the item into either the **Yellow** or **Purple HOLD** tray on the right side of the screen.  
**C a Subfile** which relates to the test item **OR** stay in the Test list.  
**C Test Item In Hold Tray** (directly beneath the **Hold Tray** you are using)

This now will begin a scan and you can see how the client is responding to the information.

### *★ Option:*

**Drag and Drop** a high reactivity item into the **red HOLD ACUTE ITEM** tray on bottom of screen.  
**Check for Mental Echo / Check for Casual Echo / Check for Enteric Echo / Check for Curative Echo.** Selecting these items will give you further information and hints.

## **Harmonic Coupling** (see **Figure 9** – pg 21)

This function is at the bottom of the Test Screen. If it is not visible you may need to extend your screen to use it.

Harmonic Coupling is useful for determining whether two items will work harmoniously together or not.

If compatibility is below 80 do not use the items together.

**Drag and Drop** any two items into the **purple Harmonic Coupling of Two Items** tray (on the bottom of your screen)

**Search Harmonic:** this will bring the items into harmony.

**Emotion Focus:** note information in **yellow** lines. **DBL C** to treat.

**Homeo Focus:** gives homeopathic information. Treat if desired.

**General Focus:** note information / treat.

**Top 6 Homeopathic:** note information / treat.

**Drag and Drop** any two items into the **purple Harmonic Coupling of Two Items** tray.

**Check for Harmonic Compatibility:** brings up a **yellow** screen - the harmonic will appear in **red**.

**Expand Name** (see **Figure 9** - pg 21)

**C** highlight an item

**C Expand Name** (this will give you a connection to Homotoxicology & Spinal)

**Searching for an Item** (see **Figure 9** - pg 21)

The **Search** key is below the **Individual Reaction** key.

Type in whatever you would like to know more about into the Search box (such as: wheat, hair loss, acne etc.) Now a **Search** key becomes highlighted next to the box.

This is a sample word search, so the Matrix will display any items containing that word.

Should the **Search** not turn up the information you are seeking, you may try an alternative word.

**C Search** a list of related items will now come up on the Matrix
